Being an Open Eco Homes host is good fun and easy. All we ask you to do is make your house and yourself available for two days in October (Sunday 8th and Saturday 14th) and help us create a case study for visitors by answering some questions. On the day you'll give up to four pre-booked tours of your house with a maximum of 8 people on each tour.

We'll do everything else – take bookings, advertise the event, provide you with a volunteer steward if you need one. We'll also invite you to a post event hosts party.

How we select homes and hosts

We want real homes so your home doesn't have to be perfect. What is important to us though is a high level of commitment to low energy principles, techniques and technologies and a desire to pass that on to others.
